- † Understand that you are guilty of sinning against a holy God by violating His Moral Law (The Ten Commandments).
- † Realize that the just punishment for your sin is eternity in hell.
- † Believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, who was sacrificed by dying on a cross because of your sin. He was buried and rose from the dead three days later. Jesus then returned to heaven and is at God's right hand today.
- † Repent of your sins (i.e., turn away from and forsake your sins; submit to God's will and authority).
- † Trust that Christ's sacrifice satisfies the justice of God's wrath against your sin, and "put on Christ"¹⁹ to escape the wrath to come, just as a person would put on a parachute to jump from a crashing airplane.
- † Accept that you cannot be saved on the basis of what you do but on the basis of what Jesus did. He perfectly kept God's holy standard and offers to give His righteousness to all who genuinely believe and repent of their sin.
- † Understand that a **true** Christian, as enabled by the Holy Spirit, obeys God out of a grateful heart for His gracious gift of salvation.
- † Realize that you can only be saved by **grace alone**, through **faith alone**, because of **Christ alone**.

ARE YOU A GOOD PERSON?

Wanted!

A "few good people."
Think you qualify?
Take a shot at the
"good" test and see if
you pass...

You shall not lie.¹

Have you ever lied (even once—a fib, a white lie, an exaggeration)?

You shall not steal.²

Have you ever stolen (anything—the value is irrelevant)?

You shall not commit adultery.³

Jesus said, "Whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart."⁴

Have you ever looked at someone with lust?

If you said "Yes" to these three questions, then **by your own admission**, you are a lying, thieving, adulterer at heart; and we've only looked at three of God's Ten Commandments.

You shall have no other gods before Me.⁵

Has anything or anybody ever been more important to you than God?

You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain.⁶

Have you ever used God's name as a curse word? If a man accidentally strikes his thumb with a hammer and then uses God's name in the place of a four-letter filth word to express his disgust, the Bible calls it blasphemy. Not even Hitler's name is despised enough to be used as a curse word. Have you ever done so with the name of your Creator, who gives you life, health, family, & everything you hold dear? The Bible states, "The LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain."⁷

Honor your father and your mother.⁸

Have you ever disobeyed or disrespected your parents (even if they didn't know it)?

You shall not murder.⁹

The Bible states, "Whoever hates his brother is a murderer."¹⁰ Jesus said, "Whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment."¹¹

Have you ever hated anyone (even for a brief moment)?

You shall not covet.¹²

Have you ever jealously desired to have something that belonged to someone else?

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.¹³

Do you spend regular time worshipping and honoring God?

The Bible states, "There is none who does good, no, not one."¹⁴ God knows everything that you have ever done. Nothing is hidden from His holy eyes. The Bible states, "It is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment."¹⁵

Will you be innocent or guilty on the Day of Judgment?

Listen to your conscience. You know that you will be guilty and, therefore, end up in hell.

Perhaps you disagree because you believe your god is a god of love, and he would never send you to hell. If so, you're right! Your god would never send you to hell, because he could not; he's a figment of your imagination.

You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything...you shall not bow down to them nor serve them.¹⁶

Or perhaps you believe your god would not send you to hell, because your god is good. Try that with an earthly judge in a court of law. Imagine a man in court, found guilty of rape & murder. What if the man said, "Judge, I believe you're a good man. Because of your goodness, I'd like you to overlook my crimes and let me go free." Isn't it true this judge would prove himself to be corrupt if he let the criminal go unpunished? Do you expect less from God, the righteous Judge? Since God is just and holy and good, He cannot excuse your sin. If He did, He would not be just and holy and good, but corrupt. God will not only punish all rapists and murderers but all liars, thieves, fornicators, adulterers, idolaters, etc. He will even judge our words and our thoughts.

NOTICE

If you are not convinced that you are guilty and have sinned against a holy God, therefore **earning** His wrath, go back to the start and take the test again. Otherwise, proceed...

God provided a way for you to be pardoned. He sent His Son to take your punishment: "God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."¹⁷ The Son of God became a man so that He could die in the place of sinners and pay the penalty we owe. "The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."¹⁸ You broke God's law, and Jesus paid your fine with His blood.
